A panel of experts for an evening blending innovation and tradition

A judging panel made up of industry professionals, innovation experts and specialised journalists will assess the entries based on criteria such as technology, environmental performance, economic impact and the originality of the projects.

The winners of the 2025 edition will be honoured at an exceptional evening event, to be held on 18 November, the opening day of the exhibition, in the prestigious setting of the Parilly racecourse, a stone's throw from Lyon Eurexpo. Nearly 300 guests are expected to attend.

This symbolic location was chosen as a nod to the 180th anniversary of the FFC, owner of SOLUTRANS, and to the legacy of industrial bodywork, whose roots go back to the trade of wheelwright and horse-drawn vehicles.

The Berliet Foundation, which has been working for over 40 years to preserve the heritage of heavy-duty vehicles, will also be honoured. It will receive a special award and will exhibit several vehicles, both at the racecourse and in the aisles of the show.
